# Albany Steeple Walk




Albany City Hall was originally designed by Phillip Hooker in 1832. After it was destroyed by fire, a new one was built in 1883 by Henry Hobson Richardson in his typical Romanesque Revival style.

The New York State Capitol is the fourth capitol building. It was completed in 1899 at a cost of \$25 million dollars, equal to about half a billion in today's money, and the most expensive government building at the time. It was designed and built by four architects over its 30 year construction: Thomas Fuller, Leopold Eidlitz, Henry Hobson Richardson, and Isaac G. Perry.

New York State Education Department was designed by Henry Hornbostel in the Beaux Arts style and opened in 1912. Its 36 hollow marble columns with corinthian capitals is one of the longest colonnades in the world.

The Governor Nelson A. Rockefeller Empire State Plaza was built between 1959 and 1976 at an approximate cost of \$2 billion. It was designed by Wallace Harrison. It consists of marble and steel buildings. It contains Corning Tower, The Agency Buildings, the Cultural Education Center, Robert Abrams Building for Law and Justice, the Legislative Office Building, and the Swan Street Building.
